ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTIVE NO. 2007 -

INTERPRETER FEES


Administrative Directives 89-11, 89-12, 90-1, 95-15, and 2000-73 relating to the payment of foreign language interpreters and interpreters for the deaf and hard-of-hearing are hereby amended. The fees established in this directive for the payment of all interpreters shall remain in force and effect until amended or superseded Rules or by a decision of the Court of Criminal Appeals or by the Oklahoma Supreme Court.

Interpreters shall be paid not to exceed Sixty Dollars (\$60.00) per hour from the local court fund for actual time worked either in court or out of court. Fees shall not exceed Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) per day. Mileage shall be paid pursuant to the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

All claims must be approved and paid according to state law. Interpreters shall not be paid from the court fund unless they were appointed by a valid court order prior to the time they provide their services.

This directive shall take effect on 1 day of May, 2007.
